The Center for Environmental Health and the Natural Resources Defense Council are pleased to offer the following comments concerning the proposed listing of styrene:

The proposed listing meets the requirements of the Proposition 65 regulations. An authoritative body, the National Toxicology Program, has formally identified styrene as a carcinogen in the Twelfth Report on Carcinogens. The National Toxicology Program found that there was sufficient evidence in animals to make this determination, thus satisfying the regulation's scientific sufficiency criteria. The scientific basis of the determination has been confirmed by the National Research Council.

We urge OEHHA to move expeditiously to complete the Proposition 65 listing of styrene.
