#### Master's Degree:

- **Research Scientist II**  
(Epidemiology/Biostatistics;  
Chemical Sciences) plus 3 years  
of research experience
- **Associate Toxicologist** plus 3  
years of experience or a doctoral  
degree in Toxicology,  
Pharmacology, Biochemistry, or  
closely related specialty

#### Doctoral Degree:

- **Research Scientist III** plus 1 year  
of research experience
- **Staff Toxicologist (Specialist)** plus  
3 years of postdoctoral experience

#### Medical Degree:

- **Public Health Medical Officer**
